

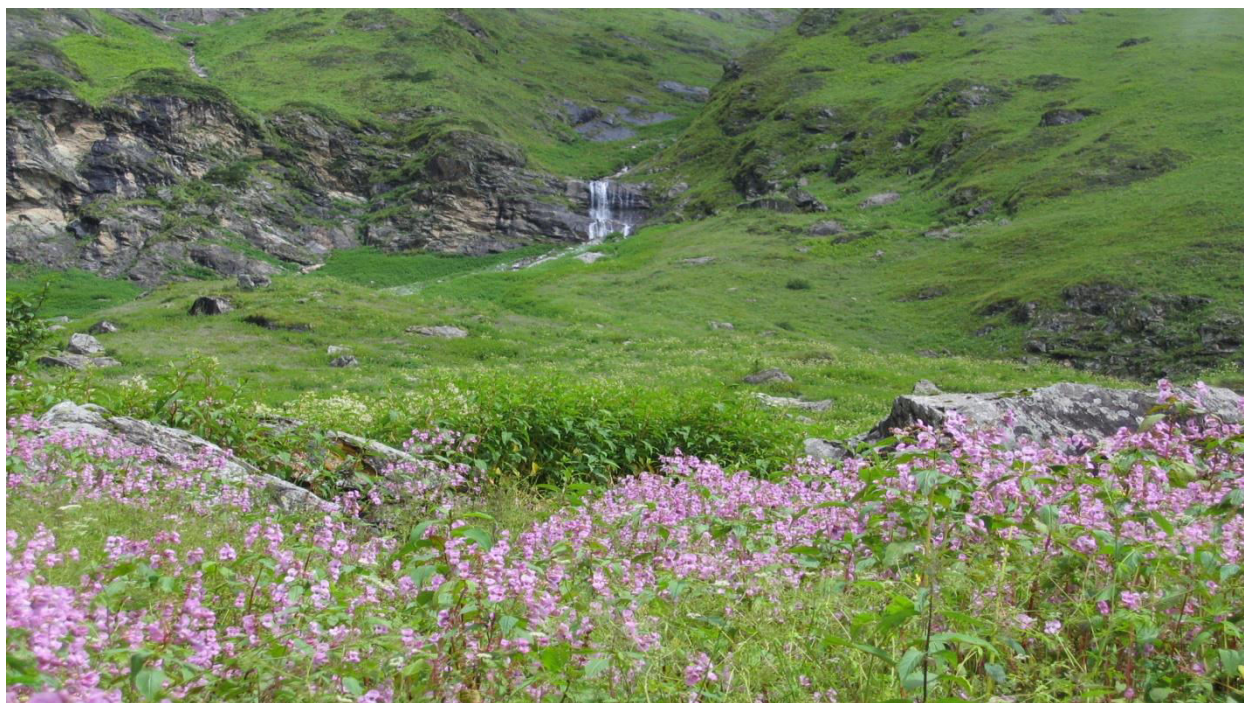

13th to 18th August 2017

HARIDWAR TO HARIDWAY (6 DAYS.)

About Valley of Flowers:

Valley of Flowers National Park is an Indian national park located in West Himalaya, in the state of Uttarakhand and is known for its meadows of endemic alpine flowers and the variety of flora. There are some 300 hundred species of flowers present here.

Some of the prominent species of flowers here are Sediums, Lilies, Poppy, Calendular, Daisies, Denthus, Turmopsis. The splendor and the scintillating beauty of the valley attract tourists from all over the world. Trekking in this beautiful valley is like walking in Switzerland and the beauty of Valley of Flowers is enchanting and soothing to the eyes and mind. It is situated in Nanda Devi Bio Reserve, and all activities are carefully regulated to preserve the valley in pristine condition.

Brief Itineray :

Day-01	13.08.2017	Rishikesh – Joshimath by Road
Day-02	14.08.2017	Joshimath - Govind ghat - Ghangria
Day-03	15.08.2017	Ghangria - Valley of Flowers & back to Ghangria
Day-04	16.08.2017	Ghangria - Govind ghat – Badrinath & stay
Day-05	17.08.2017	Badrinath to Joshimath & stay
Day-06	18.08.2017	Joshimath to Rishikesh

Pl. Note:

- We would be leaving Rishikesh on 13th August by morning 6 AM, accordingly participants have to reach Rishikesh on their own.
- On 18th August we would leave Joshimath after Breakfast and reach Rishikesh by evening, accordingly return journey to be planned.
- DUE TO LEAVE ISSUE OF FEW MEMBERS, DATE HAD TO BE CHANGED FROM 12TH MAY (AS WAS MENTIONED IN VERY 1ST CIRCULAR) TO 13TH MAY. AND ALSO AS HEMKUND IS STRENUOUS, MANY MEMBERS AVOID GOING THERE; HENCE BADRINATH IS BEING INCLUDED INSTEAD OF HEMKUND.
- NOTE: ATTENDING ANY 2 TREKS/EVENTS OF SAAD IS COMPULSORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPANTS.

How to Reach Rishikesh :

- **By Train:** Plenty of trains available via Delhi and then too Haridwar. Direct train available to Haridwar, is less, suitable for our trek is Train No. 12171 Mumbai LTT – Haridwar AC Express leaving Lokmanya Tilak Terminus. From Haridwar, one can get Auto, Bus, Taxi till Rishikesh Hotel.
- **By Flight:** Nearest airport is Dehradun airport, 20 Kms. From Rishikesh.

FEES: Rs. 15,000/- (RISHIKESH TO RISHIKESH)

+ Membership fees (for those who are not members)

(Life Membership Fees: Rs.5005/- / Yearly Fees: Rs. 505/-

- Hotel stay in Joshimath, Ghangria & Badrinath (Twin Sharing)
- Camping, Permit Fees, Equipment Charges etc
- Vegetarian B/f, Lunch & Dinner
- Rishikesh - Joshimath- Govindghat – Badrinath – Joshimath - Rishikesh Transportation

Exclusions:

- Mumbai – Rishikesh & back travelling charges
- Stay in Rishikesh
- Personal Porter, Dandi / Khandi, Mules charges.
- Any kind of Insurance during trek or transit
- Bisleri / Cold drinks etc
- Hot water in Ghangria for Bathing
- Personal Porter / Mules.

Cancellation Policy:

1/4th amount of the total trek charges (i.e. Rs. 15,000/-)

Note:

- Porter/mule charges for carrying Individual luggage is Rs.250/- per day per luggage.
